



Procedural steps to become an SNU Trainee Healing Medium for students not resident in the UK.

1. Apply to join the Spiritualist National Union (SNU) as a Provisional Individual Member. Membership is renewed annually. Application for membership is available online at <http://www.snu.org.uk/membership/individual.html> or alternatively the form can be downloaded from the same webpage and returned to the above head office address.

2. Apply to register as a Trainee Healing Medium on the downloadable application form which can be found under quick links on the Website or using this link <http://www.snu.org.uk/healing/training> . Application forms to be returned to the Registered Head Office Redwoods and must include a passport sized photograph. Registrations are renewed annually in April.
 - 2.1 Once an individual is registered, the administration team will send to the applicant a credential card which has their photograph on, Code of Conduct and Healing and the Law document and a logbook. The logbook maps out the necessary criteria that are needed to become an SNU Registered Approved Healing Medium.

3. Training period a minimum of 12 months 2 signatures a week – 100 practical sessions of contact healing.
 - 3.1 Sessions to be signed off by the patient (if the trainee is not a member of a church and unable to access an SNU Registered Approved Spiritualist Healing Medium to supervise practical healing sessions)
 - 3.2 This Training is a minimum of 12 months and a maximum of 5 years.

4. Apply and register on the H1 (Basic Healing Course). Application form available online at http://www.snu.org.uk/education/educ_enrol.html .The form and payment can be completed electronically or alternatively printed and returned with the relevant fee to the Registered Office, Redwoods.
 - 4.1 The administration team will send to the applicant either printed course notes or a PDF copy of the notes and the contact name of Course Organiser who will allocate a tutor to support the trainee while they are studying. The tutor will contact the student directly once the Course Organiser has allocated the student to them.
 - 4.2 This course must be started within 6 months of registration, by the submission of question 1 to the tutor and must be completed within 2 years of the registration date.
 - 4.3 To complete practical training in 12 months the H1 course must also be completed and passed within 12 months at grade B 70% or higher.

Training sessions can be complete in various ways which are:-

- a) Attend SNU Healing Week 1 at the Arthur Findlay College (see programme for details).
- b) Provisional or full member of an SNU Church or Centre in country of applicant.
- c) Apply for membership with SNUi and attend the online healing training, sessions.

Review sessions

- a) Attend SNU Healing Week 2 at the Arthur Findlay College (see programme for details, dates and cost). This course covers healing mediums review sessions and upgrade assessments.
- b) Through an SNU Church or Centre in country of applicant.
- c) Attend sessions on SNUi online healing training and sign off sessions verified by tutor facilitating the SNUi course.

Criteria for a Trainee Healing Medium

5. Carried out the necessary procedure as laid out in the Training Programme, as well as the following criteria:
 - 5.1 Receptionist for at least 12 weeks within the 100 practical training sessions, detailing patients' names, addresses and attendances.
 - 5.2 Kept confidential notes on each patient and any advice offered.
 - 5.3 Kept a record of donations received.
 - 5.4 Assisted in the preparation and clearing of the healing area for at least 12 weeks of the 100 practical training sessions.
 - 5.5 Assisted an SNU Approved Healing Medium when discussing problems with a patient.
 - 5.6 Where appropriate, attend, with an SNU Approved Healing medium, patients in their own homes and /or hospitals.
 - 5.7 Attend at least 100 practical training sessions and completed the enclosed record sheets and have them signed by patient.
 - 5.8 Understand the law as it bears on healing.
 - 5.9 Understand the SNU's Healing Code of Conduct (including insurance), which the Spiritualist Healing Medium signs to accept on either their initial application form or reregistering application form. The re-registering form is sent annually from Head Office.
 - 5.10 Know how to communicate and act with doctors and patients.
 - 5.11 Understand the positions and functions of the main organs of the body at an elementary level.
 - 5.12 Understand how meditation, relaxation and visualisation can assist in the healing process.
